Packaged ELICOS: The minimum IELTS score to undertake a packaged English Language Intensive Courses for Overseas Students (ELICOS) program has increased from 4.5 to 5.0.

Students who are unable to meet the academic or English language criteria may in some cases be eligible to undertake our Language, Literacy & Numeracy (LLN) test. Criteria may change at any time without notice. 
